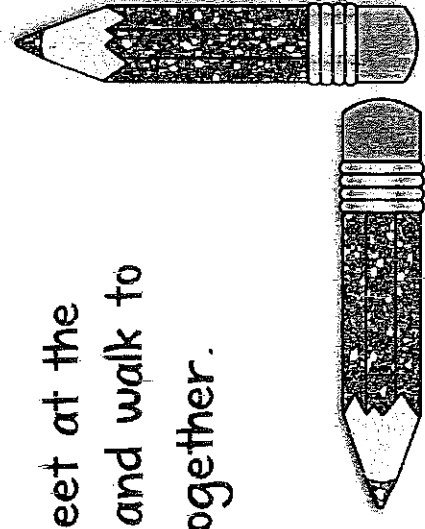

Let's meet at the corner and walk to school together.

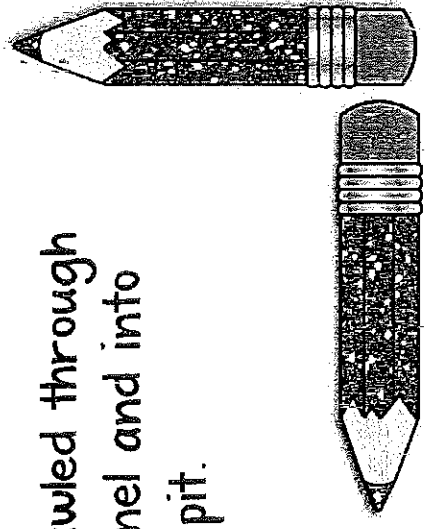

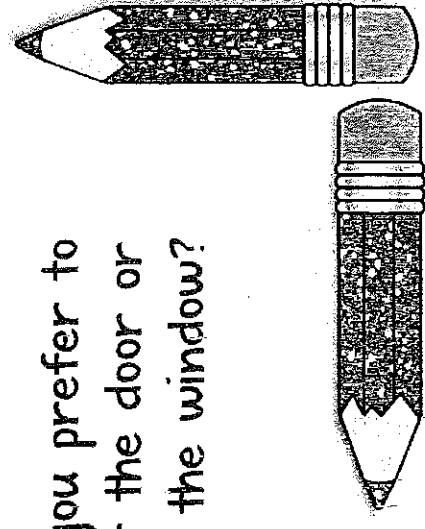

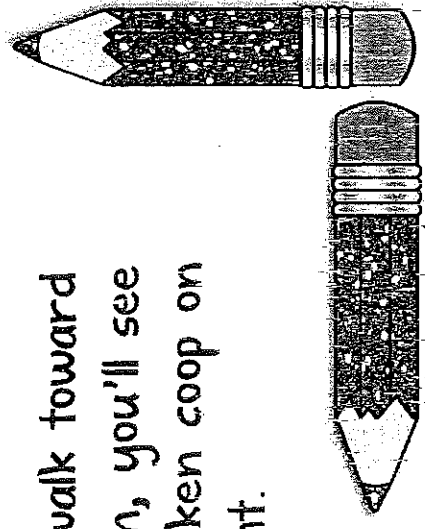

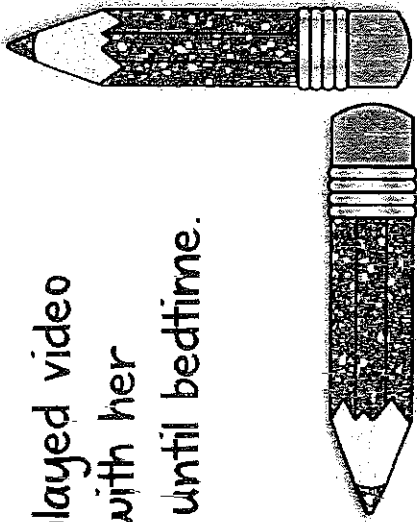

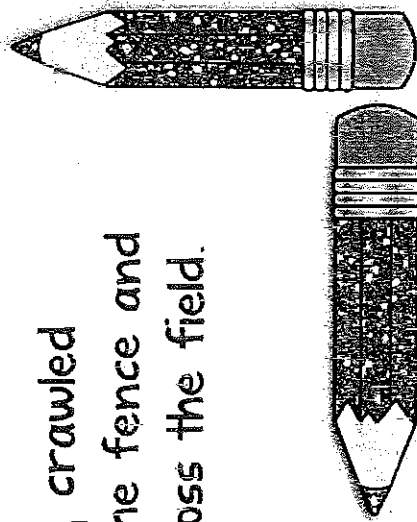

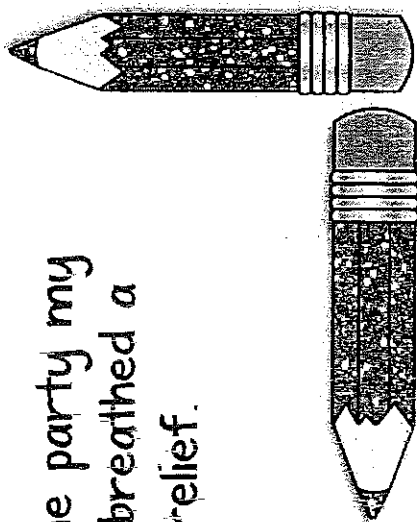

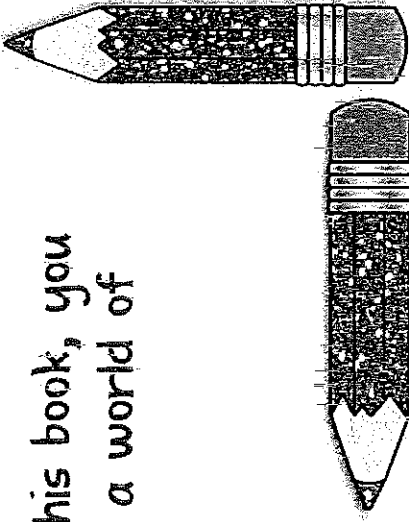

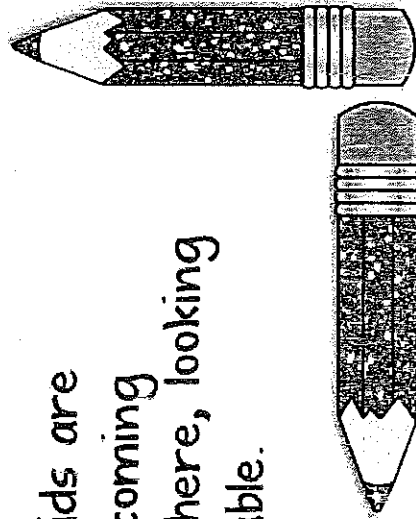

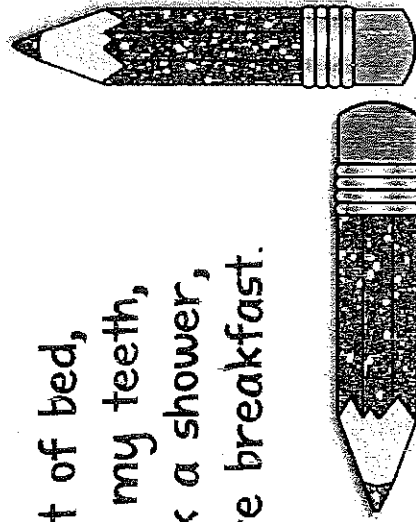

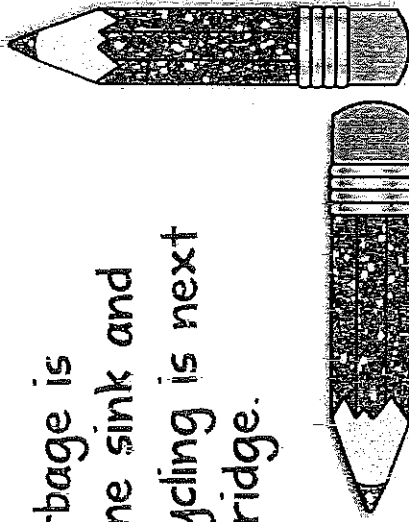

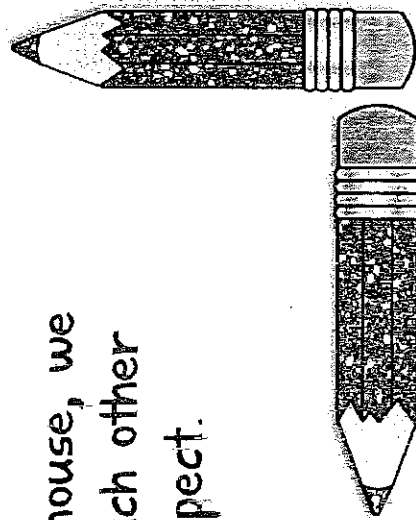

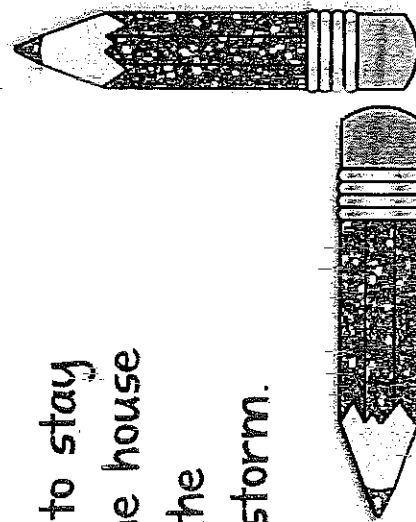

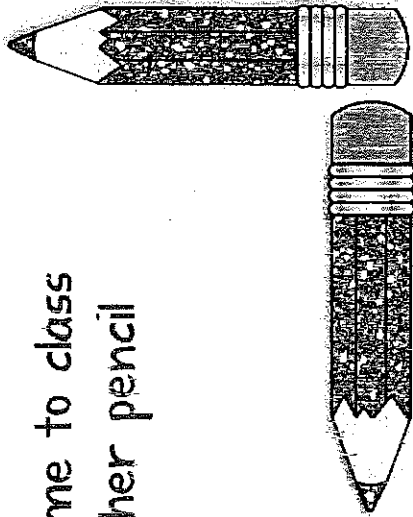

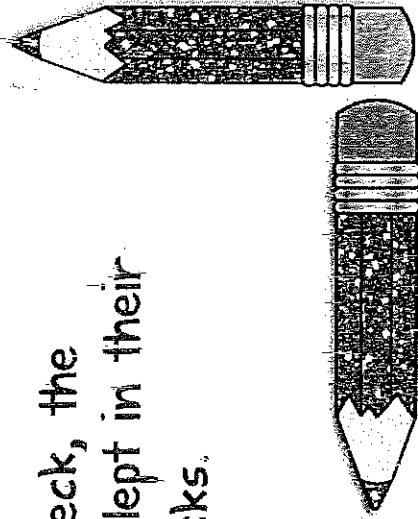

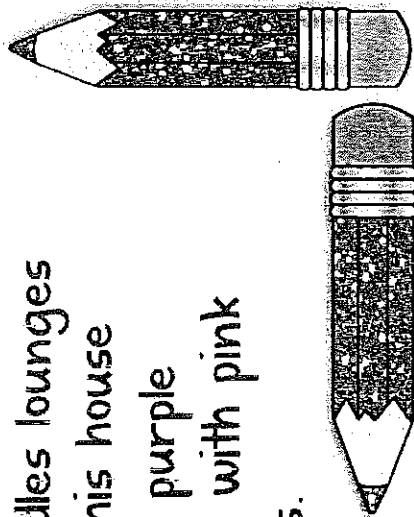

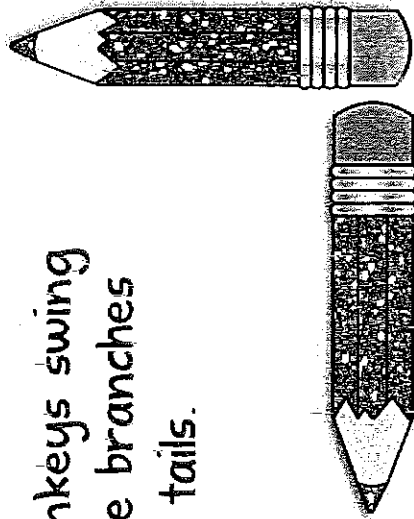

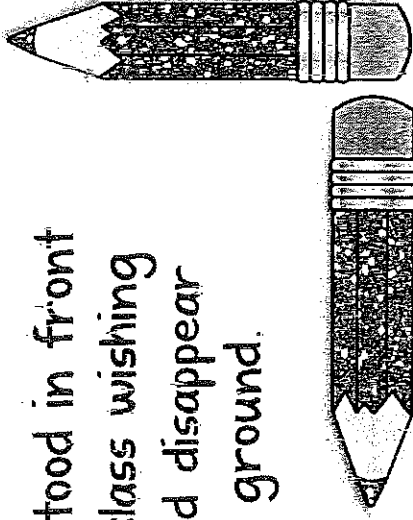

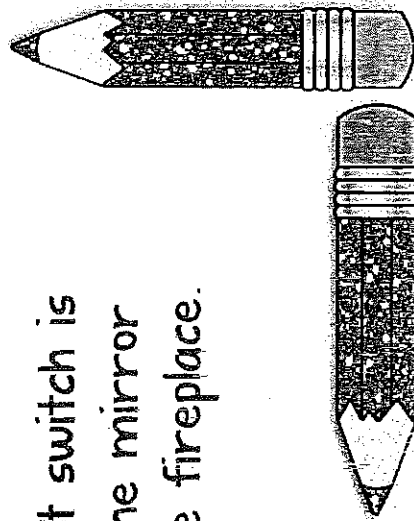

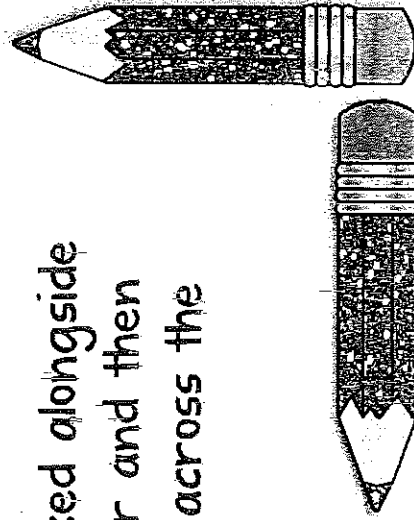

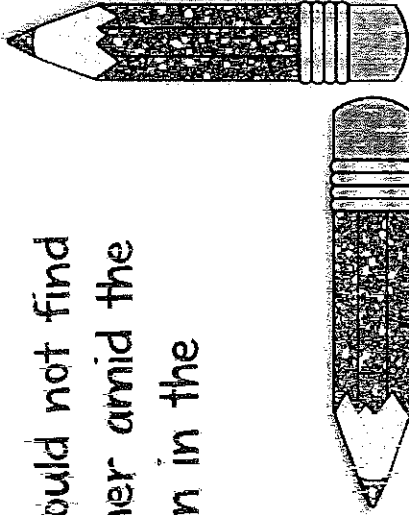

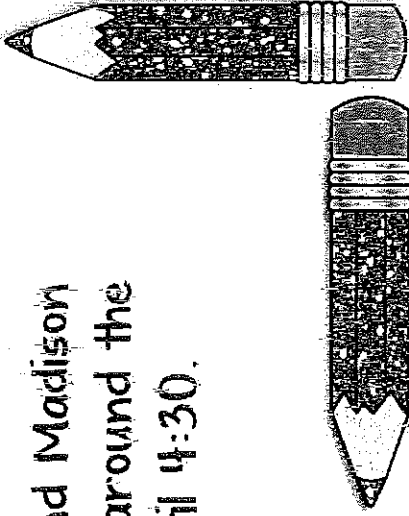

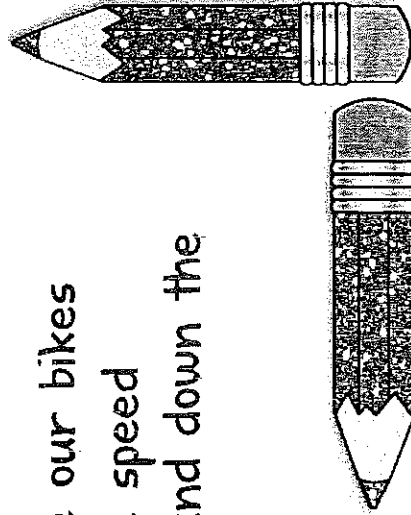

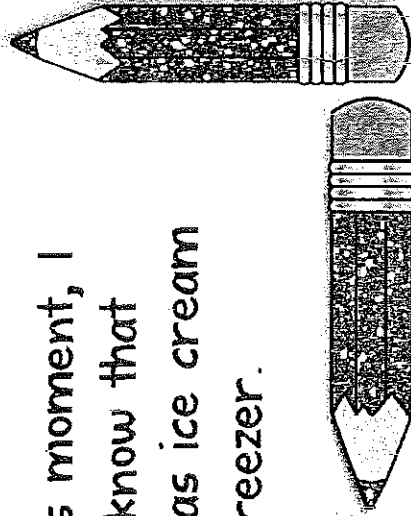
